2009 Parade Rules and Regulations

1. All participants must turn in the official entry form. All applicants are subject to review by the Javelina Alumni Association. Those who do not turn in an application are not eligible participate. Parade applications will be received only in person. To drop it off in person please bring the application to the Office of Alumni Affairs at Texas A&M University Kingsville located in Seale Hall RM #103. Please turn it in no later than **5:00 PM on Friday, October 16, 2009**.
2. A Copy of your Proof of Liability Insurance Coverage is required and must be turned in with this application. Only those vehicles listed on your application with proof of insurance will be eligible for the parade.
3. **No late applications will be accepted.**
4. The Parade Director will confirm your parade registration by telephone or email. If you have not received a confirmation by **Tuesday, October 20, 2009** we do not have a completed application. If this occurs please contact the Alumni Office immediately at 361-593-4176.
5. All entries must arrive at the staging area (Kleberg County Courthouse, corner of Kleberg and 12th Street) no later than **5pm on Thursday, October 22, 2009**, and may arrive as early as 4pm. **The parade will begin promptly at 6:00pm. (All official times will be determined by the “Homecoming Clock” provided on site).**
6. Due to safety, once the parade has begun, individuals may not leave his/her parade entry until the parade route has been completed.
7. **No spirit items may be thrown from the float.** All items must be handed out by the people walking alongside the float.
8. Entries are encouraged to display the sponsoring business, organization, and/or group name.

9. The first 20 floats to arrive at the staging area will receive one bag of spirit items to hand out to the crowd during the parade.
10. Parade entries are encouraged to provide additional safe items which can be handed out along the parade route (i.e. Beads, candy).
11. Floats are restricted to 20 ft in height due to potential interference with property such as power lines. Only one vehicle may pull a float, no other vehicles may accompany the entry.
